ASSABET VALLEY CHAMBERSINGERS

The Assabet Valley Chambersingers, an adjunct ensemble of the Assabet Valley Mastersingers, offers wide-ranging vocal programs to diverse audiences in a variety of local venues. The Chambersingers perform unaccompanied madrigals and motets from all periods as well as Broadway show tunes and vocal Jazz standards.

Organized in 1983 by Director Robert Eaton as a civic outreach program in the greater Worcester area, the Chambersingers have performed at venues such as the Arts in Common Westborough; Marlborough, Shrewsbury, and Northborough Library programs; at Assisted Living Facilities, community meals programs and other social service organizations; and special concerts in Northborough, Southborough, Clinton, and other area communities.



CHORAL PROGRAM

Programs are designed and revised to suit the occasion. Christmas programs include a variety of traditional choral settings; other programs may be developed around particular themes.
